

Admission Requirements:

To apply for admission to the College, applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Hold a Secondary School Certificate or its equivalent.
2. Submit a secondary school certificate authenticated by the Ministry of Education for foreign certificates.
3. The applicant's age must not exceed 35 years for morning study programs. There is no age limit for evening study programs.
4. Graduates of previous academic years are eligible to apply to the College departments.

Registration Requirements

Applicants must provide the College with the following documents upon registration:

1. Completed application form filled out by the student and the school and certified by the Ministry of Education.
2. Information form in English.
3. A colored copy of the Civil Status ID (National Identity Card) with the original for verification.



4. A colored copy of the Iraqi Nationality Certificate with the original for verification.
5. A colored copy of the ration card with the original for verification.
6. A colored copy of the passport for foreign students with the original for verification.
7. Medical examination report.
8. Eight (8) recent photographs with a white background (3 × 4 cm).
9. Residence card or proof of residence.
10. Secondary school graduation document certified by the Directorate of Education, to be submitted during the first semester.

Graduation Requirements

To be eligible for graduation, the student must:

1. Successfully complete the approved curriculum of the department with at least a passing grade.
2. Prepare and defend a graduation research project with a passing grade.

3. Complete the required summer training (internship).
4. Obtain departmental clearance.
